



**Dr. Margaret Dennis, Orofacial Pain Management: *Facial Pain Diagnosis in the 21st Century***

This presentation will cover the possible causes of facial pain including nerves, muscles and joints and how to tell the difference.

**About the speaker:** Dr. Margaret Dennis grew up in Dade City, Florida with her sister and the "best parents" a person could have. She attended Georgia Southern College, earning a Bachelor's degree in Biology and then went on to earn her Doctor of Medical Dentistry degree from the University of Florida College of Dentistry (1987). Soon after, Dr. Dennis opened her own dental practice in Jacksonville, FL (1990). Due to injuries she sustained in a motor vehicle accident in 1995, Dr. Dennis had to stop practicing dentistry. At the same time, her sister had been experiencing terrible facial pain issues which led to an interest in exploring the world of Orofacial Pain. Dr. Dennis took courses from Drs. Dawson, Spear, Kois and Piper and completed the curriculum in both the Dawson Academy and Piper Education and Research Center. In 2001, she sold her practice, completed a residency at the University of Kentucky, College of Dentistry (2002) and returned to Jacksonville to open the Orofacial Pain Center where she treats patients who have issues with nerve pain, TMJ, migraines, autonomic nervous system damage and malocclusion.

**Dr. Susana Perry, Pediatric Dentistry: *Pediatric Dental Trauma Management***

Traumatic dental injuries occur frequently in children and young adults. Proper diagnosis, treatment planning and follow up are important in order to attain the best outcomes. This lecture will provide a summary of the International Association of Dental Traumatology (IADT) guidelines and present the best current evidence for managing dental injuries.

**Dr. Shreena Patel, Orthodontics: *The Advantages of Interceptive Two-Phase Orthodontic Treatment***

Dr. Patel will review the benefits of using interceptive two phase orthodontic treatment including: managing canine eruption to minimize impaction, Rapid Palatal Expanders to shorten second phase treatment time, Habit Appliances, and early Class III therapy with Facemask treatment.

**About the speaker:** Dr. Shreena Patel graduated from The Bolles School in 1998. She then continued her education at the University of Florida, where she received her Bachelor of Science in Nutritional Sciences, her Doctorate of Dental Medicine, and a Master of Science in Orthodontics.
